How to Escape The Tribulation by Voyle A. Glover

There is coming upon the earth a period of seven years Jesus described as the worst time in all of human history. There have been some horrific times on the earth in our past. During the time of the Nephelim, giants who roamed the earth and other monsters that were hybrids of various creatures, human life was precious. There was a time when humans were hunted by these beasts and giants for food.

But, Jesus said that there would be a time worse than that. He said: "For then shall be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world to this time; no, nor ever shall be" (Matthew 24:21).

Christians have long known of this period of time called the Tribulation, or in some circles, Jacob's Troubles. While there exists some in the Christian community who differ, these are people who have chosen to ignore certain evidences and ignore early historical writings of the early church fathers.

God Made a Way of Escape for Noah and His Family

The historic Christian community has long known of this Tribulation period and take literally the words of Jesus. They also take literally the warning of Jesus that there would come a time akin to the time of Noah, where Noah and his family were taken to a place of safety, inside a huge ship God had directed Noah to build. Immediately after entering the ship, God loosed a deluge of water upon the earth that drowned all life on the planet except Noah and his family. These were the only righteous people left on the planet. God brought Noah and his family to safety, then disaster came upon the earth and the inhabitants of the earth.

Jesus promises to do that same thing for those who are God's children, those whose righteousness is found in Jesus Christ. He warned everyone of the coming tribulation time.

And, Jesus told of some who would escape that time. Here's how he described that escape by some:

- (37) "But as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.
- (38) For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark, (39) And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. (40) Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. (41) Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left. (42) Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come." (Book of Matthew 24:37-42).

Do you want to escape the wrath of God?

That's what's coming in the Tribulation period. That is the time called Jacob's Troubles. It is a time when Israel will undergo some very serious testings. Many Jews will die in this time. God is going to pour out His wrath on the earth, on the inhabitants of the earth.

God Does Not Pour Out His Wrath on His Children

But, God does will not pour out his wrath on His children. He will not pour out His wrath on the Church, called in Scripture "the Bride of Christ." God will make a way of escape for the Church, for those who are Christians.

But, it is not sufficient to be a Christian in name only.

There has to be what was called by Jesus a "born again" process.

Jesus told a Jewish teacher in Jerusalem that in order for a man to enter heaven, he had to be "born again." That man did not understand what Jesus was saying. Many other people do not understand this, either. Here is what he told that Jewish teacher: "Jesus answered and said unto him, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God" (John 3:).

Simply put, in order for a man or woman to enter heaven, that man or woman must be spiritually born. She or he must be a spiritual person. His or her spirit much be made one with God. You have to be one with God. You must be a new person, a new man, or as scriptures say, a "new creature in Christ."

The Apostle Paul said: "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new" (2 Corinthians 5:17).

A person who is "born again" is a person whose spirit suddenly receives the gift of life. That life is the Spirit of the living God. His Spirit joins with your spirit which creates a brand new spiritual being. The Bible calls this new creation a "new man."

The Apostle Paul said: "And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness" (Eph 4:24).

It is literally, a brand new entity: your spirit merged with God's Spirit, creating a spiritual entity, a spiritual being that is you, your soul, your identity, merged into God's Spirit.

The Apostle Paul summarized it thusly: "But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit" (1 Corinthians 6:17). That is your spirit joined, or merged, with God's Spirit, creating a brand new, unique person, a totally spiritual person.

HOW CAN YOU BECOME A NEW SPIRITUAL PERSON?

So, how does one become a new person? How does one become a spiritual being? How does one merge his spirit with God's spirit and emerge a new person?

Put in simple terms, you have to come to Christ, in belief, and surrender yourself to God. You must believe that Christ is the **ONLY** way to heaven, the **ONLY** salvation.

As the Apostle Peter said:

"Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole. (11) This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner. (12) Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved" (Acts 4:10-12).

So, will you come to Jesus for salvation?

Here's a message Jesus delivered to some Jews during his time on earth: "And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst. (36) But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not. (37) All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out" (John 6:35-37).

Did you catch the fact that Jesus wants you to come to him?

So, how do you come to Jesus?

Simple. Kneel before him, bow your head to Jesus, pray and ask Jesus to save you, to deliver you from the evil to come. Tell him you are giving your life over to him to do with whatever he wants. Tell Jesus you want his salvation, the only true salvation.

Do that truthfully. Do that in your heart. Do that for real.

God will not turn you aside. God will not reject you. It does not matter what you've done. *God will forgive it*.

The Apostle Paul felt he was the "chief" of all sinners. He'd dragged Christians all over Israel into prison, had them killed, tortured, and beaten. Christians feared Paul. Then, there came a time when Paul had an encounter with Jesus that was life changing. He met Jesus and came to realize that the person he hated and despised, was in fact the Savior of mankind. The Christians he was persecuting were in fact, more righteous than he was. They had truth. He had a lie. They knew Jesus. All he knew was the law and religion.

And so, Paul called himself the chief of sinners. He said to Timothy in a letter: "This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief" (1Timothy 1:15).

Do you want to escape the wrath to come? Jesus Christ is the **ONLY** way to escape. *There is no other way.*

If you disregard this message and find yourself one day on the other side of the Rapture, a time when you look around and realize that the godly people, the Christian people are all missing, and they're not all dead in missile attacks or earthquakes or anything like that. They are ALL gone, which is statistically improbable. When you realize this, you'll realize this message was true.

It's still not too late.

If the Rapture has already taken place, it is too late to be snatched out of the bad times. But, you will escape the wrath of God. *You will escape Hell*.

You will likely die during the Tribulation. I'm not mincing words here. I'm giving you reality.

The man who takes over the world will target all Christians. He will cause all Bibles to be burned. And, he will cause all to accept a mark, it's called the "Mark of the Beast," and those who take that mark will be doomed to Hell.

Do not take it.

Accept death by any means.

Take a water gun and charge an army of soldiers, if you must.

Better to die than to take the mark.

"And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, (10) The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb" (Rev 14:9-10).

So, escape the Tribulation now.

And, if the Rapture has already occurred, kneel before God NOW and give him your life. Surrender your soul to God. Accept Christ as Saviour. Give Christ your life, completely.

If you can, warn as many people as possible. Give them this document. Help them come to Christ. Warn them of the danger.
